

Camper Guidelines & Restrictions

A fun part of camp life is taking advantage of the opportunity to simplify our lives. To ensure a rewarding and entertaining experience for all Little Planet campers, the following is list of restricted and recommended items so that you can plan what to bring to Summer Camp at the Lagoon:

- **Electronic devices** including **computers, cell phones, video games** and **audio/DVD players** are not welcome at camp. If these items must be brought to camp for personal reasons, they will be held by Little Planet staff and returned to campers upon their departure. Little Planet is not responsible for stolen or lost equipment.
- Expensive, elaborate **jewellery** and **watches** have no place at camp. They can they be easily lost during camp activities and can also potentially cause injury. Little Planet is not responsible for lost jewellery and watches.
- **Cash** is not required at camp.
- Any **junk food** and **snacks** brought to camp will be held by Little Planet staff and returned to campers upon their departure. Bringing snacks into cabins can result in uninvited critters and animals. Snacks will be made available to campers in the cafeteria every day.
- Campers are not permitted to bring **knives** or **duct tape** to camp. Little Planet will provide all equipment needed for excursions and overnight trips.
- All shower gels, shampoos, conditioners and soaps should be biodegradable (glycerine based and phosphate free) and unscented. Note that perfumed products attract insects and small animals.
- Overly **revealing clothing** is strongly discouraged, including swimwear such as thongs and bikinis.
- Campers who normally wear contact lenses will need their glasses for overnight experiences and trips.
- **Alcohol, cigarettes** and **drugs** are strictly forbidden. We have a zero tolerance policy on alcohol and drugs and any campers who are found with any of these items will be sent home immediately. Cigarettes and tobacco will be confiscated and a call will be made to parents. A second incident will result in the camper being sent home. Parents will always be contacted and transportation arrangements will be made. There will be no refunds granted for fees paid for campers being sent home for these infractions.
- **Poor behaviour:** We have a zero tolerance approach to campers using **inappropriate language, violence** or **bullying**. Disruptive, disrespectful or inappropriate behaviour directed at staff or other campers will not be tolerated. Initial incidents will be brought to the attention of parents. If there is no significant change, the Summer Camp Director reserves the right to send a camper home. Parents will always be contacted and transportation arrangements will be made. There will be no refunds granted for fees paid for campers being sent home for behavioural reasons.
